

Constantin Paleologu was born in Romania in 1975. In 1998 he received a M.Sc. degree in telecommunications networks from Faculty of Electronics, Telecommunications, and Information Technology, University Politehnica of Bucharest, Romania. He also received a masters degree in digital signal processing in 1999, and a Ph.D. degree (*MAGNA CUM LAUDE*) in adaptive signal processing in 2003, both from the same institution. As a Ph.D. student (from December 1999 to July 2003), he worked on adaptive filters and echo cancellation. Since October 1998 he has been a member of the Telecommunications Department of University Politehnica of Bucharest, Romania, where currently is an Associate Professor.



His research interests include adaptive signal processing, speech enhancement, and multimedia communications. He published more than 70 papers in journals and conference proceedings. He received 4 “Best Paper” awards at international conferences (*International Conference on Telecommunications – ICT 2001, International Conference on Computing in the Global Information Technology – ICCGI 2006 and ICCGI 2007, International Conference on Networking – ICN 2008*). He co-authored 3 books and 7 application notes for students. He was the project manager of 5 national research grants (one of which is still in progress).

Constantin Paleologu is a member of the *IEEE Signal Processing Society*. He serves as a reviewer for several international journals (*IEEE Transactions on Audio, Speech, and Language Processing, IEEE Transactions on Circuit and Systems - Part I – Regular Papers, IEEE Signal Processing Letters*) and international conferences. He also served as a member of the Technical Program Committee for several international conferences (*International Conference COMMUNICATIONS 2006 and 2008, International Conference on Computing in the Global Information Technology – ICCGI 2007, ICCGI 2008, and ICCGI 2009, International Conference on Networks – ICN 2009, International Conference on Digital Telecommunications – ICDT 2009*). He was the co-chair of the *International Conference on Computing in the Global Information Technology – ICCGI 2008*, Athena, Greece.
