Dr. Michael Massoth is a full professor of telecommunication, business informatics and computer science at the h_da Hochschule Darmstadt – University of Applied Sciences, Germany, since 2005. He is a member of the special technical board for telecommunication, business informatics and IT-security at the department of computer science. He is also a member of the Center for Advanced Security Research Darmstadt (CASED) as a principal investigator in the research area “secure services” since 2010.

Dr. Massoth is a lecturer in computer science, especially in telecommunication, multimedia networks and services, mobile communication and computing.

Before his appointment as professor he worked as manager sales and researcher at the Mobile Research Center (MRC), TZI – Center for Computing and Communication Technologies at the University of Bremen.
